

Smoke Free Policy

Rationale:

Smoking poses significant health risks to both smokers and those around them. Smoking is not permitted in designated public spaces such as schools and early childhood centres as per the Smoke Free Environments Act 1990.

Objectives:

- To ensure that smoking does not occur on the Small World site at any time.

Procedures:

- Smoking is not permitted at any time within the Small World site (building and environs).
- Staff will politely but firmly remind smokers that smoking is not permitted.
- Smoking is not permitted at any time by any adult participating on a Small World excursion.
- Signage will be maintained to remind users of Small World of this policy.
- Staff who smoke outside of the Small World environs during designated breaks will wash their hands and use breath fresheners before recommencing work.
